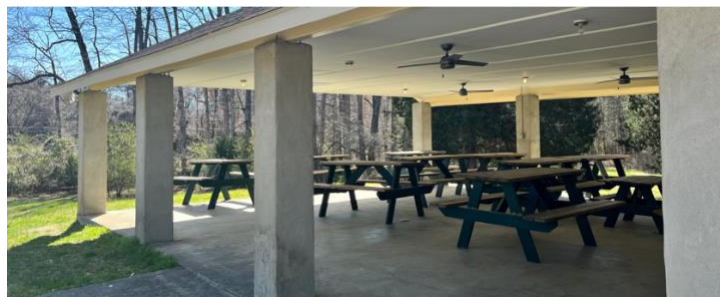
Founded in 1902 by [Dr. Charlotte Hawkins Brown](#), Palmer Memorial Institute transformed

the lives of more than 2,000 African American students. Today, the campus provides a setting where visitors can explore this unique environment where boys and girls lived and learned during the greater part of the 20th century. The museum links Dr. Brown and Palmer Memorial Institute to the larger themes of African American history, women's history, social history, and education, as well as emphasizing the [contributions of African Americans](#) in North Carolina.
